The Board of the Faculty of Education and Psychology, Universidade Católica Portuguesa, announces the opening of applications for the 2025/2026 academic year for the **Micro-credential program—Collaborative Pathways to Inclusive Education**.

1. Admission Requirements / Eligible applicants

To hold a bachelor's degree and work as a faculty member, researcher, and/or senior staff member who works directly with higher education students in a university or polytechnic institution, or, alternatively, be enrolled in a bachelor's degree program designed to prepare students for future teaching careers.

3. Application dates

4. Required documentation

- Copy of identification document (ID card or passport)
- Bachelor's degree certificate¹ or enrollment statement¹ (for students who are still completing their bachelor's degree)
- Statement from the employer (university or polytechnic institution) or equivalent document proving professional or institutional affiliation

¹ Documents issued in other countries will have to be legalized by the Portuguese diplomatic or consular authority in the issuing country, or contain the Hague Apostille, except for United Kingdom, and countries from EU, or European

Economic Area, or European Free Trade Association. When they are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, English or French, the respective translation must be delivered, carried out in accordance with the provisions of the notarial law.

6. Application evaluation and selection criteria

Applicants will be selected and ranked according to the following criteria:

- Faculty member, researcher, or senior staff member who works directly with higher education students and is affiliated with one of the four T4EU partner institutions (Universidade Católica Portuguesa, University of Alicante, Saarland University, Vytautas Magnus University) | (10 points)
- Student enrolled in a bachelor's degree program designed to prepare students for future teaching or research careers at one of the four T4EU partner institutions (Universidade Católica Portuguesa, University of Alicante, Saarland University, Vytautas Magnus University) | (9 points)
- Faculty member, researcher, or senior staff member working directly with higher education students at another university in the T4EU alliance | (8 points)
- Student enrolled in a bachelor's degree program designed to prepare students for future teaching or research careers at another university in the T4EU alliance | (7 points)
- Faculty member, researcher, or senior staff member working directly with higher education students at an HEI outside the T4EU alliance (6 points)
- S Student enrolled in a bachelor's degree program designed to prepare students for future teaching or research careers at an institution of higher education outside the T4EU alliance | (5 points)

Professional experience in training or teaching | (10 points)



7. Admission Results

The results will be expressed as follows:

The final ranking of applicants is expressed on a numerical scale ranging from 0 to 20.

- b) Viewing of all available video lectures; viewing of other resources is optional;
- c) Completion of the final project for Module 3: *Classroom Transformation Plan*.
